DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT



As I reflect on 2020 - an unprecedented year in so many ways - I'm amazed by Tasveer's many achievements. From creating a superb team to introducing new initiatives and new ways to deliver them, this year we continued amplifying South Asian voices all around the US. I'm filled with gratitude and pride looking back at what our creative and indefatigable team has

been able to achieve, working together from their homes to put together new and innovative programs that kept our community engaged and entertained through the difficult times:

Even virtually, April's **Yoni Ki Baat** kept up the program's tradition of bringing honest, personal storytelling to the community.

In October we marked the 15th anniversary of the **Tasveer South Asian Film Festival** by partnering with six other North American South Asian film festivals for the first and largest **Coalition of South Asian Film Festivals** (CoSAFF). CoSAFF saw Tasveer's name and reputation elevated to the national and global level. During TSAFF, we also awarded the first-ever **Tasveer Film Fund** grant, to support South Asian filmmakers working in the US.

We celebrated the power of literary voice and the written word through Tasveer Author Meets, a book club, and at the second **Tasveer South Asian Literature Festival** (*TSAL*), a weeklong series of programs featuring 35 writers Zooming in from around the world.

Ongoing stand-alone programs like Tasveer Reels, Community Speaks, and Youth Collective outreach events rounded out an unexpectedly complicated year, during which it was more important than ever to maintain and expand Tasveer's presence as a reliable, engaging, and thought-provoking South Asian arts organization. COALITION OF SOUTH ASIAN FILM FESTIVALS + TASVEER SOUTH ASIAN FILM FESTIVAL

This year, we featured over **65** films at our **FREE** virtual festivals CoSAFF and TSAFF, and had a total of **45,000**+ attendees from all over the world. We hosted industry days with key industry insiders, Q&As with filmmakers, and more.



TASVEER SOUTH ASIAN LITFEST

We hosted the 2nd Tasveer South Asian Litfest (TSAL) in 2020. This **FREE** event attracted over **3,000** global attendees who enjoyed a week of readings, author Q&As, panels, and literary discussions on contemporary topics.

One of our most popular legacy programs, Yoni Ki Baat (YKB) went virtual in 2020 for its **15th year.**Five participants performed for over **1000** audience members. We also helped **API Chaya** raise over **\$4000** through YKB.

To serve and engage more South Asian youth through film, literature, and art-related workshops led by South Asian community members.


To share more diaspora stories by supporting more filmmakers, writers, and artists from our community with new platforms, programs, grants, and more.






To increase South Asian representation by curating programs that explore and illuminate the full diversity of the South Asian experience.
